CONDITIONS

1. This permit may be used only by the designated permittee and only for the purpose, location and time period stated.
2. This permit is issued with the understanding that all use made of the area designated will be in conformity with the rules and regulations of the Palisades Interstate Park Commission and the instructions of the Director of Group Camps, a designated employee or Park Police.
3. For the purpose of identification, this permit must be carried on your person or in your vehicle and be available if requested by a patrolman or park employee.
4. Permittee assumes all risks in the performance of all activities authorized by this Agreement and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the State of New York, the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, the Palisades Interstate Park Commission, their officers, employees, agents and assigns (hereinafter, collectively the "Indemnities") from and against any and all claims, suits, losses, damage or injury to persons or property of whatsoever kind and nature, whether direct or indirect, caused or contributed to by permittee and permittee's contractors, vendors, materialmen, employees, agents, invitees, sub-permittees and guests, and/or arising out of permittee's conduct and/or permittee's performance pursuant to this License, provided however that permittee's indemnity shall not extend to any claims, liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, accidents or occurrences arising out of, relating to, or in connection with: (i) the negligence of any Indemnity; and (ii) the Indemnities' ordinary upkeep and maintenance of the Park and its grounds and facilities outside of the permitted premises. Permittee shall defend at its sole cost and expense any action commenced for the purpose of asserting any claim of whatsoever character arising out of this License. Permittee's responsibility under this section shall not be limited to the required or available insurance coverage.
5. Trash and garbage removal is the permittee's responsibility and is not to be left at the site.
6. Potable water will or will not available as specified here: not available after October 15.
7. Access will be by foot or non-motorized vehicle unless conditions permit motorized vehicles to pass on established roadways.
8. Permittee shall promptly report any and all unusual incidents directly to the Area Foreman, Director of Group Camps or Park Police. Unusual incidents include, but are not limited to, damage to Park property, accidents, personal injuries and emergencies involving medical personnel.
9. The Palisades Interstate Park Commission reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time.
